

## Instructions for Participants

**(Coordinators should forward this to all participants):**

1. All participants should have a working computer to participate in this workshop
2. Please follow the instructions and links given below and get ready for the workshop.
  - a. Please ensure that you have Anaconda Python Environment installed in your system. The installation instructions are available in the link <https://docs.anaconda.com/anaconda/install/>
  - b. If you have trouble in this step, please get this sorted out before the day of the workshop.
3. Download the data files required for the workshop from this link: [https://static.fossee.in/python/python\\_content/1-day-workshop/circulate.zip](https://static.fossee.in/python/python_content/1-day-workshop/circulate.zip)
